Blue, 100/box, 10 boxes/case - On line 39 B/C/D it says MAINTEX #212834, CAMEO #6393, or approved equal.</p> <p>My concern is that the Maintex and Cameo gloves are not 5 mil gloves. Those two gloves are not 5 mil. Would it be ok to offer something that is similar to MAINTEX #212834, CAMEO #6393? Or does it need to be a minimum 5 mil blue nitrile?</p>	<p>Thank you for bringing this to our attention.</p> <p>Specification should indicate 3.5 mil – not 5 mil. Updated specification for # 39 (to be applied to 39a, 39b, 39c, 39d):</p> <p>Gloves, Nitrile Disposable, 3.5 mil, Powder Free, rolled cuff, ambidextrous, highly chemical and puncture resistant, textured grip and dexterity and must be FDA compliant. Applications: food preparation, light-duty cleaning, painting, manufacturing and parts assembly: any non-medical application. Blue, 100/box, 10 boxes/case</p>
