<b>Grade 7</b>		Spanish 1A <b>Class Type:</b> this class focuses more on 1st semester content of ECHS Spanish 1
<b>Grade 8</b>	Spanish 1 <b>Class Type:</b> this class is similar to ECHS Spanish 1 however it does not earn Spanish 1 credit ***It is recommended for students to earn a C in both semesters to be prepared for Spanish 2***	Spanish 1B <b>Class Type:</b> this class focuses more on 2nd semester content of ECHS Spanish 1 ***It is recommended for students to earn a C in both Grade 7 and Grade 8 Spanish in order to be prepared for Spanish 2***
<b>Grade 9</b>	Spanish 2 Students who complete Spanish 2 will be considered as having met the graduation requirement. It is recommended that if they are applying to a competitive college, that they continue to Spanish 3.	Spanish 2 Students who complete Spanish 2 will be considered as having met the graduation requirement. It is recommended that if they are applying to a competitive college, that they continue to Spanish 3.

- Spanish classes taken at the middle school level will not post on an OUSD high school transcript.
- However, when students enter their high school courses on college applications, there is a spot to list high school level courses taken at the middle school level.
