The School and Community

El Camino High School was opened in 1976 and serves a community that is economically, culturally and ethnically diverse. El Camino is one of two comprehensive high schools in the Oceanside Unified School District. Students have full range of academic, extra-curricular and co-curricular opportunities. El Camino has been both a National Blue Ribbon award winner and a California Distinguished School. El Camino High's 2019 ranking by US News is 441st within California High Schools and has earned a Silver Medal based on student performance on state-required tests and how well students are prepared for college. The student body makeup is 52% male and 48% female, and the total minority enrollment is 77%.
