Dear Chávez Middle School Families,

I hope that this letter finds you and your extended family healthy and excited as we prepare for the start of a new school year. The start of last year presented some unforeseen challenges, but with every obstacle, we are committed to finding solutions that support your child's education and attendance at school. We look forward to re-establishing relationships with current students and welcoming in new Chavez students. It is always our intention to make students feel seen and heard and to be clear and consistent with our expectations. Our staff will be taking time during the first weeks of school to establish a foundation of community and connection that we will continue to grow as the year progresses. Students in all grade levels will benefit from newly adopted curriculum materials in language arts and history. If they are returning OUSD students, they should have a Chromebook device and charger which they will be expected to bring each day to school. Coverage for the device will be made available again at a lower cost to you than in previous years. Literacy is fundamental to academic success, and we continue to add new and engaging books to our school and classroom libraries. Many of these have been requested by students and meet a full range of reading levels and experiences.

As we prepare to open for a new school year, we will keep you up-to-date on any latest health policies and protocols. We recognize that in order to be successful in school, our children need a lot of support from both school **and** home. Middle school is a dynamic, energetic, and magical time as students are developing into a more grown-up body, a mature brain, and a unique identity separate from the adults in their lives. A strong partnership with you will make a great difference in your child's education and their ability to navigate this time in their development. As partners, we share the responsibility of our children's success and growth. We take this role seriously and will work our hardest to carry out our responsibility while making the middle school experience a positive and productive one. We are eager and excited for the possibilities that this year ahead holds for all!

We ask that you guide and support your child's learning in the upcoming year by ensuring that:

1. Your child attends school daily, ready with all the necessary materials for the day's learning experiences
2. Your child maintains a binder and uses the school-issued planner to record assignments, due dates, and keep materials organized. Organizational skills will help your child with the multiple assignments from various teachers.
3. Your child completes assignments given by teachers, and the work submitted is their own.
4. Your child shares with you their work and their Google classroom so that you are aware of their assignments and what they are learning.
5. Your child shares their grades with you on Aeries so that you understand their progress in their classes.
6. Your child knows that you expect him/her to succeed in school, and you will inform us if you feel they need additional support in any area.
7. You keep us up-to-date with any contact information changes and communicate any concerns or help you may need so that we can work as a team to find a solution and assist as needed.

School begins for all students on **Wednesday, August 17th**. **Please note that the first three days of school are early release days.** Students can view their class schedules on their Aeries account. We will post lists on the first day of school with students' first period class. **Students and families should come to campus on the assigned dates/times listed below to check out textbooks and confirm their data.**
